- The SDA design category is Robust Housing.

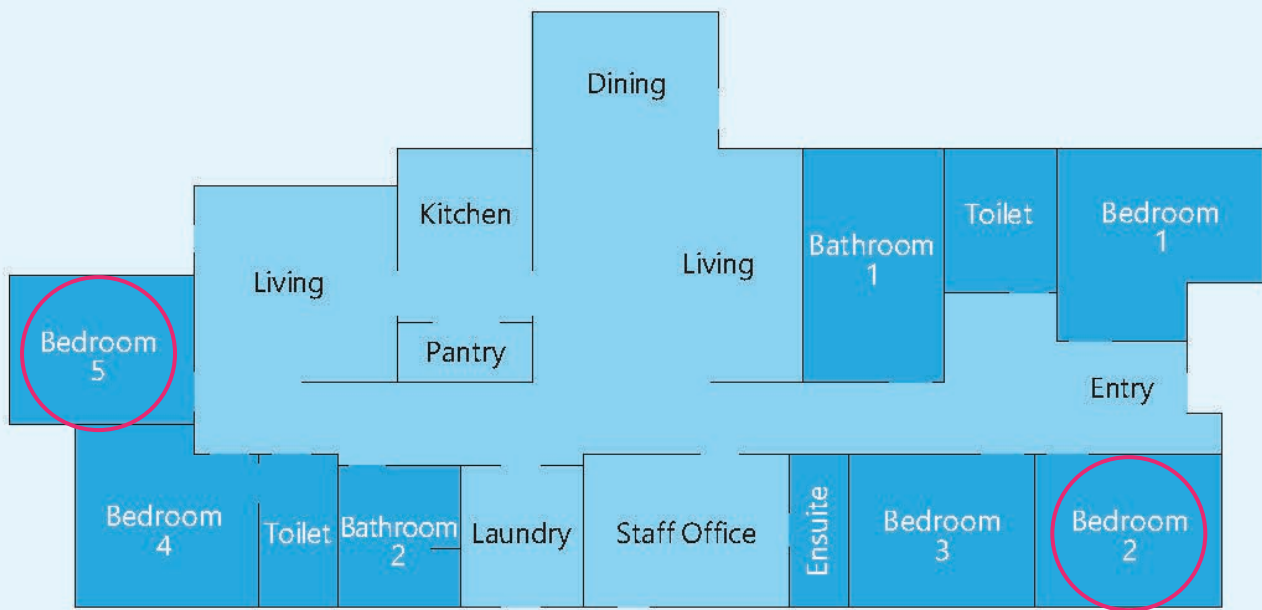
