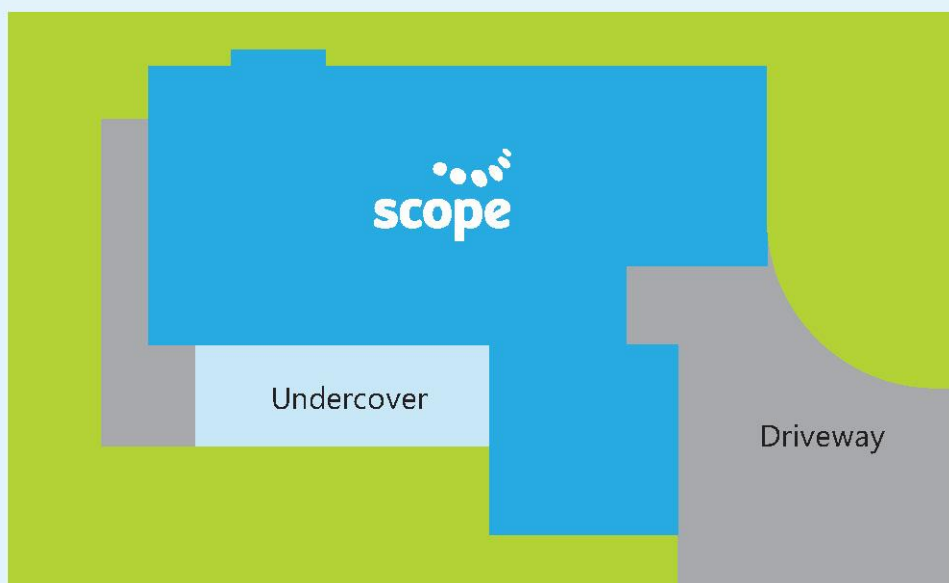
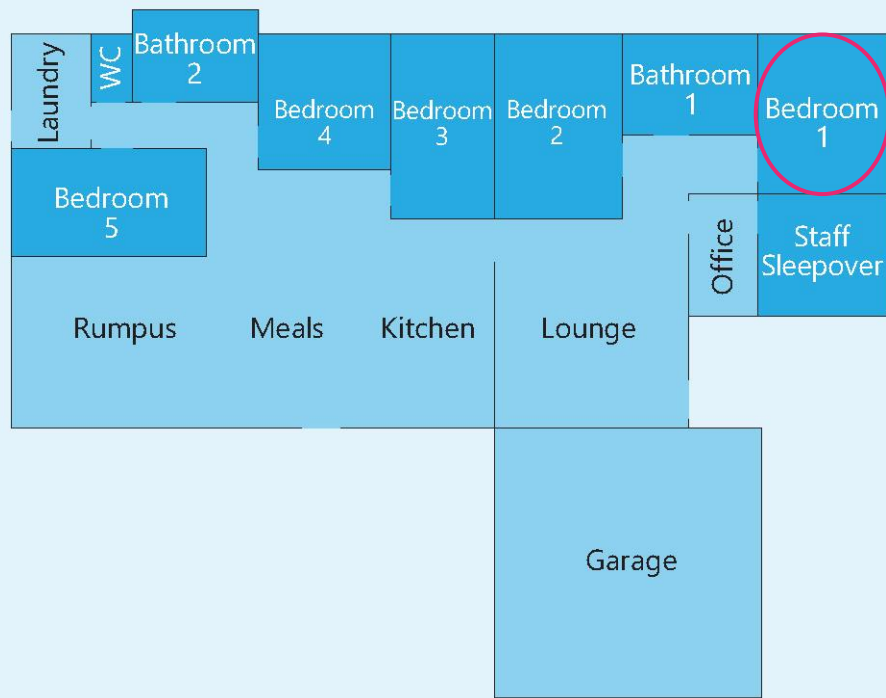
Before applying, make sure:
